(Temporary Traffic Regulation) Order 2017

NOTICE is hereby given that the Cheshire West and Chester Borough Council, in the interest of the safety of the public while the Chester Lions Fireworks Fun Night takes place on Chester Racecourse, propose to make an Order in accordance with the provisions of Section 21 of the Town Police Clauses Act 1847. The effect of the Order will be to prohibit vehicular traffic on Saturday 4th November 2017 on the following roads at the times shown:-

Nuns Road will be closed between 6.00pm and 10.00pm

A548 Sealand Road/New Crane Street/ Watergate Street between its junctions with Stadium Way and A5268 Nicholas Street/St Martin's Way will be closed between 8.00pm and 10.00pm

ALTERNATIVE ROUTES FOR TRAFFIC

The alternative route for through traffic will be via A5268 Nicholas Street/St Martin's Way, A540 Parkgate Road and A5480 Deva Link.

Pedestrian access to premises situated on or adjacent to the roads will be maintained at all times.
